- No hacking jackets.
- No double bridles.
- Plaiting is optional but give it a go!
- The Working Eq Obstacle/Sporting course will be open between 9.30 11.30am. Come and complete in between classes and open to ALL riders.
- "Novice" hacking classes refers to dressage level groups Yellow/Orange.
- "Intermediate" hacking classes refers to dressage level groups Green/Red.
- If you normally enter jumping on training days and want to enter hacking classes, then consider what dressage group you would join based on your dressage experience.
- Rider classes: "Junior" is under 18 years old and "Adult" is 18 years and above
- XC vests are mandatory for XC and everyone must have a tagged helmet.


Head on over and complete in between classes. Location to be advised on the day.

Western Bending

Rider rides straight up on the left hand side of poles, turns round the end pole, and bends back through poles, round the first pole, bending back to the end pole, around the end pole and straight back to the finish line.

Judged on time and accuracy



Barrels

Riders enter at the start line, circle around the 1st barrel, proceed to the 2nd barrel, and then continue on to the 3rd where they will complete the pattern and finally exit the course crossing the finish a second time. This pattern is often referred to as a "Cloverleaf" The pattern to begin with the RIGHT barrel first (as per image below)
Judged on time, however 5 second penalty applies if you knock a barrel over
